see why the project has impressed
the judges so much.

"We had completed two previous projects for the client, the first of which was unbuilt. while the second was a complete refurbishment of a house in Highbury," explains Mr Miltiadou. "The client then purchased the 3,000 sq ft Canonbury House site for a new build development. It's an interesting location but very constrained because it's next to a listed building and is in a very carefully controlled conservation area. Thankfully, by working with the Canonbury Society and the local community, we were able to come up with a scheme that went through with no objections. The fact that we were offering solutions to reduce onsite disruption by utilising off-site construction was particularly appreciated.

"We started demolishing the project mid-January and the client moved in in the December.

They were delighted with the end result and the quality of the project is further underlined by the award recognition it has received since. The awards have generated a number of enquires but generally we attract business via word of mouth."
